The tables below reflect the aggregated data analysis of the Student Evaluation of Teaching for the total University. Survey results for instructors teaching as PeopleSoft "Primary Instructor" during this semester have been included in the result. Results from those instructors teaching classes exclusively on-line have also been included. Only classes having 5 or more students are surveyed and those classes having fewer than 5 respondents have been excluded. The scale and survey instrument were changed in 1990 therefore comparisons to ratings prior to that year should be avoided. The present scale is 10 points with 1 representing "unacceptable" and 10 representing "outstanding".
